1. Child Care Center
2. Type A Family Child Care in your home
3. Type B Family Child Care in your home

<b>Location</b>	off-site facility	provider’s residence	provider’s residence
<b>Group size</b>	not to exceed license capacity staff/child ratio and maximum group size limitations by age group must be maintained	7-12 children	1-6 children, with no more than three children under the age of 2
<b>Staff</b>	director/administrator and any number of employees/childcare staff members	provider, employee(s), or childcare staff member(s)	provider, employee(s), or childcare staff member(s)
<b>Inspections</b>	at least one prior to provisional licensure at least two during the provisional period (12 months) at least two each state fiscal year after continuous licensure	at least one prior to provisional licensure at least two during the provisional period (12 months) at least two each state fiscal year after continuous licensure	at least one prior to provisional licensure at least two during the provisional period (12 months) at least two each state fiscal year after continuous licensure
