Medicare Premium Assistance Program



MEDICARE PREMIUM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MPAP)

TYPES OF MEDICARE PREMIUM ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS (MPAP)

Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) Covers the Medicare Part B premium; Medicare deductibles, co-insurance and co-payments.

Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB) Only pays for Medicare Part B premium.

Qualifying Individuals (QI-1) Only pays for Medicare Part B premium.



HOW TO APPLY FOR MEDICARE PREMIUM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MPAP)

- If you are already on Medicaid, please inform the Agency you are now receiving Medicare so your case is updated. Additional resource information will be reviewed.
- If you are not currently receiving Medicaid, please complete the Medicaid application. It can be found on our website, or call the Agency to request an application be sent to you.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR THE MEDICARE PREMIUM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MPAP)?

- Individual must be receiving and/or about to receive Medicare.
- Individual must meet Medicaid income and resource guidelines.

COMPONENTS OF MEDICARE

PART A helps cover inpatient care in hospitals, skilled nursing facility care, hospice care and home health care.

PART B helps cover services from doctors and other health care providers, outpatient care, home health care, durable medical equipment and many preventative services.

PART C helps cover dental and vision expenses.

PART D helps cover prescription drugs
