## WHO WE ARE

Adult Protective Services (APS) works to help keep Allen County residents, who are over the age of 60, safe. When calls are received by APS, caseworkers evaluate any risk to the safety and well-being of alleged victims. If they find there there is a risk, caseworkers work with families, social service agencies and other community resources to meet the person's needs and to improve the situation.

Our services may include, but are not limited to:

- · Case work services
- Medical care
- Mental health services
- Legal services
- Fiscal management
- · Home health care
- Housing-related services
- Guardianship services
- Placement services
- Food, clothing and shelter

Many elderly adults are abused in their own homes or in relatives' homes. Elder abuse takes many forms. It includes abuse, neglect, self-neglect or exploitation. If you suspect that an elderly person is at risk from a neglectful or overwhelmed caregiver, or being preyed upon financially, it's important to speak up. Learn to recognize the warning signs of elder abuse, what the risk factors are, and what you can do to prevent and report the problem.
